



Fun Facts About the 2009 Office Depot Foundation National Backpack Program and Tony Stewart

- If you laid all 2 million backpacks that the Office Depot Foundation has donated since 2001 end-to-end, they would:
 - Go around the 1.54-mile-long Atlanta Motor Speedway 348.5 times.
 - Make almost 358 laps around the 1.5-mile Lowe's Motor Speedway in Charlotte.
 - Wrap around the 1.5-mile-long Chicagoland Speedway almost 358 times.
 - Make more than 214 laps around the 2.5-mile Indianapolis Motor Speedway.
 - Stretch around the 1.5-mile-long Kansas Speedway almost 358 times.
- If you laid all 2 million backpacks end-to-end, they would stretch as far as a line of 171,284 of Tony Stewart's No. 14 Office Depot®/Old Spice Chevrolet Impalas.
- The 2 million backpacks donated by the Office Depot Foundation weigh as much as 7,843 of Tony's cars.
- If you placed all 2 million backpacks on top of each other, they would be about the same height as a stack of 56,075 of Tony Stewart's No. 14 Office Depot®/Old Spice Chevrolet Impalas.
- If you unpacked all 2 million backpacks and laid them on the seats of the NASCAR tracks in the cities where Tony Stewart is presenting them, you could:
 - Put 16 backpacks on every seat at the Atlanta Motor Speedway.
 - Stack 12 backpacks on every seat at the Lowe's Motor Speedway in Charlotte.
 - Pile 26 backpacks on every seat at the Chicagoland Speedway (that's one whole box of backpacks + 1 more for good measure).
 - Put 8 backpacks on every seat at Indianapolis Motor Speedway.
 - Stack 24-and-a-half backpacks on every seat at Kansas Speedway.

The most important fact of all is that **2 million children** have received new backpacks since 2001 – helping them to feel more confident, be better prepared and achieve success in school throughout the year.
