



Hurricane Shutters @ \$1.87 per foot

The ReStore is absorbing the sales tax on ALL shutters from June 6 through June 20. The store is located at 1225 South Military Trail between Summit and Forest Hill Blvd. in West Palm Beach. Store hours are 10-6 Tuesday to Friday and 10-4 Monday & Saturday. The store is closed on Sundays.

The Habitat ReStore is a retail outlet where quality, used and surplus building materials are sold at a fraction of normal prices. Proceeds from The ReStore helps the Habitat for Humanity of Palm Beach County fund the construction of Habitat houses. Materials sold at The ReStore are usually donated from building supply stores, contractors, demolition crews or from individuals who wish to show their support for Habitat. In addition to raising funds, The ReStore helps the environment by rechanneling good, usable materials into use.

Habitat for Humanity of Palm Beach County (HFHPBC) is a 22-year-old, 501(c)(3), non-profit organization whose mission is to provide simple, decent, affordable homes to low income, hard working families. These families must invest 500 hours of "sweat equity" before assuming a 30-year, no-interest mortgage. HFHPBC is currently building a 27 single home project in Jupiter.
